Two paths, depending on Guided Self-Placement results

For most students, placement can be determined by high school transcript. Use the Guided Self-Placement process if

- ✓ You didn't complete grades 9-11 in a U.S. high school, or
- ✓ You don't know your high school GPA because you've been out of high school for several years

If you are learning English as a second language

- ✓ Make an appointment for the English as a Second Language (ESL) placement test by visiting deanza.edu/assessment/appt.html
