

2014-15 Transfers to UC & CSU March 3, 2016


Transfers to UC Admission & Enrollment, 2014-15

- 1,418 De Anza students applied
- 1,059 (75%) were admitted
- Of those admitted, 815 (77%) enrolled
 - 8% increase from prior year




Transfers to UC by Ethnicity

Transfer GPA ranged between 3.81 to 2.86




Transfers to CSU Enrollment, 2014-15
