Subject: De Anza College Transfers to CSU East Bay

Highlights

- Over the past 5 years, on average, De Anza transferred 90 students to CSU East Bay annually.
- Over the past 5 years, on average, De Anza transfers comprised about 4% of total transfers to CSU East Bay from all California Community Colleges.
- Full-year transfers from De Anza to CSU East Bay remained stable from 2006-07 to 2008-09 then spiked in 2009-10 and flattened out again in 2010-11.
- 48% of De Anza transfers to CSU East Bay in 2010-11 were Asian followed by 14% White, 8% Filipino, 8% Latino, 7% Black, and 7% Unknown.
- Between 2007-08 and 2009-10, overall transfers to CSU from CCC dropped from 54,971 in 2007-08 to 37,647 in 2009-10 but increased in 2010-11 to 56,959. A rate higher than the previous 4 years.
- Overall CCC transfers to CSU East Bay grew slightly between 2006-07 and 2008-09 then dropped between 2009-10 and 2010-11. During this time, CCC transfers to CSU East Bay was at its lowest while overall CCC transfers to all CSUs was at its highest.
- De Anza transfers to all CSU campuses grew by 67% between 2009-10 and 2010-11.






