- 1. **COURSE TITLE Oil Painting III -** Arts 16C 4 Units
- 2. **COURSE DESCRIPTION** Oil paint media in the production of art work through translation of visual

information. Emphasis is on particular techniques that will allow students to broaden the range of

their skills and expression. Topics include painting on paper and linen, glazing techniques, multiple

supports in one composition.

- 1. Explore painting into preliminary drawing on paper and linen.

- 5. Broaden the range of skill used in painting.
- 6. Apply knowledge of studio needs and practices to ongoing purchases of essential art materials.
- 7. Demonstrate aesthetic growth through decision making processes
- **5. METHODS:** Instructor demonstration, discussion of materials, class lectures, slide presentations of

relevant painting styles-past and present, Individual projects, and personal and group critiques.

**6. GRADING:** Evaluation will be based primarily on the completion of all assigned studio projects.

Important additional consideration will be given to participation in class discussions and critiques

every approx. every four (4) weeks. You must present at least one finished painting for each

critique.

Written evaluation: Submit a three-page written evaluation of an artist of the period. You must

include a bibliography with at least three sources, of which only one can be a website. You may

discuss the defining characteristics of the artist chosen, their origins and what you learned from them

in relation to painting.
