2. **COURSE DESCRIPTION** - Oil paint media in the production of art work through translation of visual

information, including conceptual studies, color theory and aesthetic concerns.

- 5. Apply knowledge of studio needs and practices to ongoing purchases of essential art materials.
- 6. Demonstrate aesthetic growth through decision making processes.

- 7. Utilize critical thinking skills to critique and analyze your own art works and other students' work.
- 8. Visit an art museum/gallery/space and write about applications of color principles, composition,

and painting techniques by a specific artist. You will also be asked to comment on the

institution itself.

**5. METHODS:** Instructor demonstration, discussion of materials, class lectures, slide presentations of

relevant painting styles past and present, individual projects, and personal and group critiques.

**6. GRADING:** Evaluation will be based primarily on the completion of all assigned studio projects.

Important additional consideration will be given to participation in class discussions and critiques

every approx. every four (4) weeks. You must present at least one finished painting for each

critique.

Written evaluation: Submit a one-page written evaluation for each painting due on critique day. You

may discuss the defining characteristics of the artist chosen, their origins and what you learned from

them in relation to painting.
